Regular Admissions Process at SLI

Step 1 - See Admissions for required documents

Step 2 - Prepare documents and set date for entrance tests

Step 3 - Bring your documents and take the entrance tests

Step 4 - Release of result

Step 5 - Interview

Step 6 - Confirmation of status

For Grades 1 – 9

Students are required to take entrance tests in English and Mathematics to determine a student's progress in English and Mathematics. It will also enable the school to give recommendations on how a child can prepare for enrollment. An interview is also required.

For Grade 10

Students are required to take tests in English, Mathematics and other subjects as recommended by the Principal. Students should have taken IGCSE subjects or equivalent courses in their previous school. An interview is also required.

For Grades 11 - 12

Students must meet all the requirements set by the Principal. The Principal's recommendation is required before admission.

Please remember that taking the entrance tests does not guarantee admission to the school.

The Cambridge Primary, Cambridge Checkpoint, and Cambridge IGCSE

Cambridge Primary

The programme provides a framework to develop English, Mathematics, and Science skills and knowledge in young children. The programme helps identify strengths and weaknesses of a student's learning in concerned subject areas.

At the end of Grade 6, students take the Cambridge Primary Checkpoint Tests. The tests are marked by Cambridge and this provides an indication of progress and achievement that can be compared to an international benchmark. It also shows student preparedness for entering Grade 7.

Students receive a Statement of Achievement after the tests.

Cambridge Checkpoint

At the end of Grade 8, students take the Cambridge Checkpoint Tests. The tests are marked by Cambridge and show student progress and achievement that can be compared to an international benchmark. They also show student preparedness for the Cambridge IGCSE programme.

Cambridge IGCSE

The International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) is the world's most popular international curriculum for 14-16 year olds.

The Cambridge IGCSE encourages learner-centred and enquiry based approaches to learning. It develops learner knowledge, understanding and skills in subject content, applying knowledge and understanding to familiar and new situations, intellectual enquiry, flexibility and responsiveness to change, working and communicating in English, and cultural awareness.

Student may qualify for the **International Certificate of Education**, or **Cambridge ICE**. It is a group award of the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) and requires the study of subjects drawn from the five different IGCSE subject groups.

Cambridge AS and A Levels

The Cambridge AS and A Levels provide excellent preparation for university education. They are internationally benchmarked qualifications that are widely recognized and valued worldwide.

The Cambridge AS and A Levels are accepted entry qualifications in many universities. They may also provide course credits and advanced standing in some universities.

Students may qualify for the **Advanced International Certificate of Education**, or **Cambridge AICE**. It is a group certificate which requires the study of subjects drawn from three curriculum areas.
